### Part 1: Who's On First? Understanding the Head Start Ecosystem

Participants will also have an opportunity to dig into systems by "Spinning" the Head Start Management Wheel while gaining a better understanding of how Head Start management systems interconnect ensuring programs are delivering quality services and on a continuum toward excellence. Participants will learn about key resources that will assist them personally in their leadership journey, including developing a deeper understanding of key resources designed to assist with program planning and operations at the local level.

#### Part 2: Reflecting on the Past and Planning your path Forward as a new Head Start Leader

This session will include an in-depth look into the history of Head Start and assist new leaders gain a deeper understanding of the mission and values set forth by the founders of the program.

Part 2 of this track will include an opportunity for new leaders to pause and examine their own values as well as strengthen their leadership skills. This session will challenge participants to open their heart and mind and experience all Head Start has to offer each and every person associated with this amazing program. Participants will leave the session with a greater understanding of the complexity of the program as a whole, while also gaining a better knowledge of valuable tools and resources that will assist program leaders in the service of the nation's most at risk children and families.


